

**BOROUGH OF EDGEWOOD
ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE 1057**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF EDGEWOOD, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 200-6 OF ORDINANCE 1048.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by Council for the Borough of Edgewood, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1. That Section 200-6 of Ordinance No. 1048 which reads:

“This Ordinance shall not apply to property owned by Borough of Edgewood in the exercise of its municipal functions, including, but not limited to traffic and safety signs, non-building essential service structures, and utilities. The Borough will adhere to all use regulations by district and all dimensional and setback regulations in the placement of any municipal building or occupied structures. “

Is hereby amended to read as follows:

“This Ordinance shall not apply to property owned by Borough of Edgewood in the exercise of its municipal functions, including, but not limited to traffic and safety signs, non-building essential service structures, and utilities. The Borough will adhere to all use regulations by district.”

Section 2. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent or conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed insofar as they affect this Ordinance.
