Mark Kozar –Flaherty & O’Hara

Mr. Kozar spoke on behalf of his client, Jabba Fet, LLC d.b.a. Root 174, located at 1113 S. Braddock Avenue. Mr. Kozar gave a history of the restaurant and its owners. Mr. Kozar stated Root 174 hoped to receive a liquor license to complement the food they serve, and not to operate as a bar.

Solicitor Barry asked if an amusement license were being applied for. Mr. Kozar stated that it was not. Solicitor Barry also pointed out that a full restaurant liquor license was being applied for by Jabba Fet, LLC.
