BOROUGH OF EDGEWOOD
MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL MEETING HELD MARCH 2, 2026

Council President Petrolla called the meeting of the Borough of Edgewood to order at 7:32 pm.

ROLL CALL

Upon roll call the following responded: Dr. Blasiolo, Mr. Ellis, Ms. Furman, Mr. Love, Ms. Nielsen, Ms. Yaney, and Dr. Petrolla. Also present were Mayor Sherman, Police Chief Altieri, Borough Manager Zahorchak, and Patrick Gannon for Solicitor McDermott, who was absent.

PLEDGE

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

ITEMS FROM THE FLOOR:

No public comment was received.

AUTHORIZATION TO PAY BILLS

M-1 Mr. Love moved to authorize the payment of bills for goods and services received by the borough from the General Fund in the amount of \$23,075.76. Second by Ms. Yaney.

DISCUSSION: Mr. Love noted that large items included the purchase of more salt.

Upon roll call vote the following responded yes: Dr. Blasiolo, Mr. Ellis, Ms. Furman, Mr. Love, Ms. Nielsen, Ms. Yaney, and Dr. Petrolla. **Motion carried.**

COMMITTEE ACTION

M-2 Dr. Blasiolo moved to exonerate the tax collector and his deputy for 2025 real estate tax collection remittances and to turn over all delinquent unpaid real estate taxes totaling \$25,043.36 to the delinquent tax collector. Second by Ms. Nielsen.

DISCUSSION: Mr. Zahorchak noted that this is just a performative thing that we do each year.

Upon roll call vote the following responded yes: Dr. Blasiolo, Mr. Ellis, Ms. Furman, Mr. Love, Ms. Nielsen, Ms. Yaney, and Dr. Petrolla. **Motion carried.**

M-3 Ms. Yaney read Resolution 2026-20 CDBG Opt-in. Second by Mr. Ellis.

DISCUSSION: Mr. Zahorchak stated that every three years municipalities can opt in or out to be eligible for block grants.

Upon roll call vote the following responded yes: Dr. Blasiolo, Mr. Ellis, Ms. Furman, Mr. Love, Ms. Nielsen, Ms. Yaney, and Dr. Petrolla. **Motion carried.**

BUSINESS MEETING

VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT: Mr. Zahorchak stated that the rescue truck is still unavailable.

WATER AUTHORITY REPORT: Mr. Fuller provided a report about the Water Authority, including receipt of a CBDG grant. Money is available in Phase 4 of the lead line replacement. It is free to get this done. Mr. Zahorchak noted that we will have a line replaced at Koenig Field.

RECREATION REPORT: Mr. Zahorchak provided the following report. Youth Basketball has a few more weeks left and will be wrapping up mid-March. Futsal is underway. Sign-ups for summer softball and teeball open March 23 and will be available until May 1. Our annual Easter Egg Hunt is scheduled for Saturday, March 28 at 1pm, with a rain date Sunday. The event happens at 1pm. We'll be putting eggs out on the field at noon if anyone is able to help.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Nothing was reported.

COG REPORT: Mr. Love stated that the annual dinner occurred.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT: Mr. Gannon had nothing to report.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT: Mr. Zahorchak reported that the Civil Service Commission met to discuss some changes to the civil service rules that the Chief proposed regarding promotional examinations. These can be acted on at the next council meeting. Chief Altieri would like to administer a promotional exam over the summer. Dave Davis Communications finished the network installation on the administrative side of the building.
