MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL MEETING HELD JULY 20, 2026

Council President ProTem Blasiolo called the meeting to order at 7:31pm.

ROLL CALL

Upon roll call, the following responded: Dr. Blasiolo, Mr. Ellis, Ms. Furman, Ms. Nielsen, and Ms. Yaney. Also present were Mayor Sherman, Borough Manager Zahorchak, and Solicitor McDermott. Mr. Love and Dr. Petrolla were absent.

ITEMS FROM THE FLOOR:

There were no comments from the public.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

M-1 Ms. Furman moved to approve the minutes of the June 15, 2026 Council Meeting. Second by Mr. Ellis.

COMMUNITY AFFAIRS: Ms. Nielsen reported that the committee has been interviewing junior council candidates and both will take their oaths soon.

PENSION AND PERSONNEL: The pension and personnel committee did not meet.

AD HOC COMMITTEES: Nothing was reported.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT: Mr. McDermott had nothing to report

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT: Mr. Zahorchak reported that there is a motion on tonight's agenda to award the 2026 road paving program and the street tree inventory project. The South Braddock Avenue traffic signal replacement project is complete. The Commercial Street Bridge will be demolished either July 14 or July 15, no time has been given.

COMMITTEE ACTION

- M-5** Ms. Yaney moved to award the 2026 Roadway Improvement Contract to A. Liberoni, Inc. as follows:
-Base bid including milling, paving, storm sewer improvements, concrete curb adjustments, sidewalk and pedestrian ramp improvements and line striping on in the amount of \$348,202.26.
-Add Alternate No. 3: Intersection of Beech Street and Maple Avenue in the amount of \$29,475.70
-Add Alternate No. 6: Pennwood Avenue Curb and Gutter in the amount of \$6,732.75. Second by Mr. Ellis.
